Independent, yet close by.....

.....an elder cottage is a small separate, manufactured residence for an older person that is temporarily placed in the side or rear yard of a host family (relatives or close friends). The arrangement provides autonomy for its resident, along with easy access to family or friends who can provide assistance.* When living requirements of the resident change, the cottage is moved to the home of another host family.

* Studies show that seniors who interact with family have longer, healthier and happier lives.
